1 Basis of Preparation and Accounting Policies

15 Significant Related Party Transaction

There is no significant related party transaction for the quarter under review.

16 Review of Performance

The Group had changed its financial year end from 31 March to 30 June. The first financial statements that made up to 30 June was for a 15-month period ended 30 June 2016. As such, there are no comparative figures presented in this report.

The Group's total revenue for the three month period ended 30 June 2017 was RM111.64 million. Profit before tax for the Group was RM0.35 million.

The retail segment generated a revenue of RM54.13 million and registered a loss before tax of RM0.55 million. This loss was primarily due to property, plant and equipment write-offs amounting to RM1.34 million, arising from planned rationalisation and realignment of existing store footprints in light of new shopping malls coming on stream nationwide. This caters to existing and new consumer who seek freshness of offerings as well as shopping convenience in a new environment. The group will continue to evaluate existing store performances and new store openings in prime locations.

The manufacturing segment's revenue contributed RM57.51 million to the Group. Profit before tax was RM1.14 million. Revenue in the manufacturing segment continues to be sustainable, for the foreseeable future.

The Group's year-to-date revenue for the financial year ended 30 June 2017 was RM462.14 million. Retail segment contributed RM226.99 million and the manufacturing segment, contributed RM235.15 million.

Overall, the Group's profit before tax for the cumulative twelve months' period amounted to RM5.53 million. Of this, the retail segment contributed RM2.35 million, and the manufacturing segment contributed RM3.71 million.

17 Comparison with Immediate Preceding Quarter

In the current quarter ended 30 June 2017, the Group's total revenue amounted to RM111.64 million, an increase of 3.19% from RM108.19 million in the preceding quarter. The Group's profit before tax in the current quarter declined by 67.93% to RM0.35 million from RM1.10 million in the preceding quarter.

Revenue in the retail segment declined marginally by 1.95% to RM54.13 million from RM55.20 million in the preceding quarter. This segment registered a loss before tax of RM0.55 million compared to a profit before tax of RM0.38 million in the preceding quarter. This marginal decrease in revenue and loss before tax is as a result of the rationalisation and realignment of existing stores.

The garment manufacturing segment's revenue was at RM57.51 million, an increase of 8.53% from RM52.99 million in the preceding quarter. Correspondingly, profit before tax increased by 25.41% to RM1.14 million from RM0.91 million in the preceding quarter. This increase in revenue was primarily due to an increase in our order books.

18 Prospects for the Next Financial Year

The Group is continuing to closely monitor the operating environment in the domestic and global economy. It is also exercising extra vigilance to maintain the positive momentum for the coming financial year.
