B1 Review of Performance

A turnover of 6.765 million was recorded for the quarter ended 30 June 2017 which was RM 1.702million or 33.62% higher than the preceding quarter's turnover of RM5.063 million. Higher sales turnover was due mainly to improved orders received from major customers. Net profit before tax for the quarter under review was RM0.465 million compared to RM0.205 million recorded in the preceding quarter ended 31 March 2017 which showed an increase of 126.83%. The increase in profit in the current quarter against the last quarter was contributed chiefly by the increase in sales revenues. Average selling price and raw material cost dropped by 14.38% and 3.19% respectively when compared to the last quarter. This was mainly due to different sales mix and lower raw materials' pricing.

Turnover of RM11.829 million achieved for the period ended 30 June 2017 was RM2.682 million or 18.48% lower than the turnover of RM14.511 million in the preceding year's cumulative quarters ended 30 June 2016. Net profit before tax for the quarters under review was RM0.670 million compared with RM2.291 million achieved in the preceding year's cumulative quarters which showed a decrease of 70.76% contributed mainly by lower sales revenue and higher raw material cost. Net profit after tax of RM0.530 million was achieved in the current period against RM1.631 million of the preceding year's cumulative quarters. Average selling price and raw material cost for the cumulative quarters ended 30 June 2017 was 5.70% and 4.68% lower than in the preceding year's cumulative quarters. Lower sales for the two quarters ended 30 June 2017 was due to a drop in sales orders from major customers and disruption of operation in the first quarter. Sales had picked up in the second quarter.
