Α1 Accounting Policies and Method of Computation

The quarterly financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134, "Interim Financial Reporting" issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standard Board and part A of Appendix 9B of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad Listing Requirements and should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2022.

B1 Review of Performance

The Group reported a higher turnover of approximately RM6.1 million for the quarter ended 31 March 2023, which translates to a 6% increase on the turnover of RM5.8 million for the preceding quarter. The Group also recorded an operating profit of RM0.17 million as compared to an operating loss in the comparative period. However, the Group reported lower turnover by approximately RM0.7 million or 10% in comparison to the turnover of the preceding year's corresponding quarter primarily attributed by an overall slow-down of orders from customers and likely contributed by the cumulative festive holidays and general economic slowdown during the first quarter of the year. The loss before tax and net loss for the period was primarily due to lower turnover but slightly offset by improvement in material and other costs.

B3 Prospects for the Current Financial Year

The Group anticipates a year of economic slowdown, with elevated operating costs and market competition. Growth targets of the Group remained buoyed from substantial growth opportunities based on prospective and new customers, available production capacity and sustained demand for our products across various essential sectors including food, pharmaceutical and household products. Should such opportunities materialize, the Group expects their contribution to be meaningful and allow the flexible packaging business to achieve further growth and economies of scale.

Barring any unforeseen circumstances and with steady improvement of the macroeconomic environment during the financial year, raw material prices are anticipated to steadily come down and have a positive impact on the performance and profitability of the flexible packaging business.

The Group maintains continuous improvements of its production facilities and machinery, and in midst of implementing next level of certification while planning for further facility upgrades and new machinery which may allow the Group to operate more efficiently and improve long-term cost management.

The Group will also continue to explore business opportunities with a view to diversify its' earnings base and ultimately enhance returns for the shareholders. Therefore, management remains bullish on the growth aspects of the Group and are cautiously optimistic with respect to the performance of the Group for the current financial year.

As the Company recorded a net loss for the cumulative quarter, no tax effects have been recorded accordingly.

The subsidiary of the Company, Sino Peak Sdn Bhd recorded a tax expense of RM7,000 for the guarter.

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B14 Other Income/Expenses

Other income mainly comprises of investment income, sales of scrap materials and sales of cylinders. The decrease in other income by approximately RM0.13 million in comparison to the preceding year's corresponding quarter was primarily due to lower investment income earned and the gain on sale of fixed asset recorded in the comparative period.

Other expenses mainly comprise of administrative, selling and distribution expenses and other factory overheads incurred during the period. A decrease is seen as compared to the preceding year's corresponding quarter mainly due to the one-off costs incurred for the corporate exercises recorded in the comparative quarter.

B15 Foreign Exchange Exposure/Hedging Policy

The Group carries out foreign exchange hedging as and when required.

B16 Trade receivables

The Group's normal credit term ranges from thirty (30) days to ninety (90) days. Other credit terms are assessed and approved on a case-to-case basis. The trade receivables predominantly comprises customers of the Group and non-related parties to the Group. The Group uses ageing analysis to monitor the credit quality of the trade receivables and a substantial amount of the trade receivables that were past due and over ninety (90) days have been collected as at the reporting date.
