ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE BURSA MALAYSIA'S LISTING REQUIREMENTS

B1. Review of Performance of the Company and its Subsidiaries

The Group's revenue for the 6 months financial period ended 31.12.2011 (Q2 FY2012) increased by RM97.0 million or 46.9% as compared to the preceding year corresponding period ended 31.12.10 (Q2 FY2011).

The growth was mainly attributed to the additional revenue contribution from Jeco (Pte) Limited (Jeco) of RM69.4 million for Q2 FY2012 as compared to last year corresponding cumulative quarters. The Group completed its acquisition of Jeco on 20 December 2010. Excluding the contribution from Jeco, the Group also achieved reasonably well with a growth of 12.9% driven by its sales growth in both the boutique and consignment sales outlets.

The Group reported a pre-tax profit of RM52.8 million for Q2 FY 2012 which is 187.9% higher than the profit of RM28.1 million reported for Q2 FY2011. The commendable results were attributable to higher sales generated, as well as the contribution of profit before tax of RM21.3 million from Jeco.

B2. Comments on Material Changes in the Profit Before Taxation for the Quarter under Review as Compared with Immediate Preceding Quarter

For the current quarter under review, the Group recorded a profit before tax of RM21.2 million as compared to RM31.6 million in the preceding quarter ended 30 September 2011.

Revenue decreased marginally by 0.5% as compared to last preceding quarter. There was also a decrease in profit mainly due to the decrease in gross profit margin from 61.2% to 57.3% as a result of clearance of stocks during festive season with lower mark-up in addition to the higher operating expenses incurred during the current quarter under review.

B3. Current Year Prospect

Malaysia's economic expanded 5.8% in the third quarter of 2011, driven mainly by domestic demand as well as the recovery in the manufacturing sector amidst slower global economic growth. Global economy activity is set to moderate this year amid heightened uncertainties over the pace of recovery in the advanced economies. However, the Malaysian economic is expected to continue to grow in view of the implementation of the 10th Malaysian Plan and Economic Transformation Programme initiatives.

Based on the positive economic outlook, the Group will continue to explore new business opportunities locally and overseas. Recently, the Group, through its Singapore subsidiary, was successfully appointed as the master Franchisee for "Renoma Café Gallery" from its Licensor, Renoma S.T.A.R for the territories of Malaysia, Singapore and Indonesia. A first concept "Renoma Café Gallery" will be launched in the mid of 2012.

On the overseas front, the Group will continue to rebuild its retail base in Vietnam after the fallout with its previous partner. In addition, the Group continues to build up its business in Indonesia after the successful launch of the Group's first exclusive BONIA boutique in Indonesia.

Amidst the Group's business expansion plans aboard, barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Board of Directors is of the view that the Group's performance for the remaining financial year will remain prudent and will continue to grow, albeit at a slower pace.
