Notes to Interim Financial Report.

1. Accounting Policies

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of FRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Company for the year ended 31 December 2007.

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted by the Group in this interim financial report are consistent with those adopted in the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2007

2. Audit Report

The audit report of the Group's most recent annual audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2007 was not subject to any qualification.

3. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

Overall, the business operations of the Group were not affected by any seasonal or cyclical factors.

4. Unusual Items

There were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income, or cash flows during the financial period under review because of their nature, size, or incidence.

5. Changes in Estimates

There were no changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior quarters of the current financial year or changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior financial years that have a material effect in the current quarter.

10. Events subsequent to the end of the current financial period

There were no material subsequent events that have not been reflected at the date of issue of this announcement.

11. Changes in the Composition of the Group

The changes in the composition of the Company and of the Group for the current quarter and up to the date of issue of this report were as follows:

- (a) On 31 January 2008, the Company through it's wholly-owned subsidiary, Infotalent disposed its entire 30% shareholding in AINB Solutions (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd, consisting of 300,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each for a cash consideration of RM300,000.00.
- (b) On 6 May 2008, the Company through it's 55% owned subsidiary, Asialink Technology Development Limited ("Asialink HK"), invested RMB250,000 in Beijing Asialink Technology Development Limited ("Beijing Asialink"). Subsequent to the said investment, Beijing Asialink is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Asialink HK.
- (c) On 27 May 2008, the Company through Aialink HK, subscribed another 69,930 ordinary shares of AUD1.00 each in MyUnos Australia Pty Ltd ("MyUnos Australia"). Subsequent to the said subscription, MyUnos Australia remains as a 70% owned subsidiary of Asialink HK.

The aforesaid changes will not have any significant effect on the earnings of the Company and Group for the financial year ending 31 December 2008.

12. Changes in Contingent Liabilities or Contingent Assets

There were no contingent assets or liabilities as at the end of the current quarter and at the last balance sheet date.

13. Review of Performance

The first quarter of 2008 saw a lower revenue stream from its traditional Systems and Solutions Division and from the Communication and Multimedia Division. The Teachers Training programme, which contributed to the revenue of the first quarter in the previous year, had been completed by mid 2007 and there were no corresponding revenue from this source in the first quarter of 2008 for the Education Division. As a result, revenue for the first quarter of 2008 was RM 8.7 million compared to RM 29.2 million for the same period of 2007. This has led to a loss of RM 2.8 million for the first quarter compared to the profit of RM 3 million for the first quarter of 2007.

14. Review of Quarterly Results

The result for the fourth quarter of 2007 was affected by 2 major adjustments in the Systems and Solutions Division arising from a sales return and the reclassification of a sale to a lease. The revenue for the first quarter of 2008 also reflected a fall in revenue in its Communication and Multimedia Division leading to the group posting a revenue of RM8.8 million for the first quarter of 2008 compared to a negative revenue of RM 20.5 million for the previous quarter and a net loss of RM2.9 million and a profit of RM 1.1 million for the same period.

15. Current Year Prospects

The Group will continue to focus and grow its strengths in the supply of a comprehensive and integrated range of ICT products and services to both the government and commercial sectors. It also sees new business opportunities from the intention by a large Telecommunication Provider to introduce the RM 15 billion Fibre-to-the-Home (FTTH) broadband access. The Group had submitted bids to participate in the pilot project with key European and Chinese suppliers of telecommunication equipment.

The Group has submitted several other major bids in the supply of ICT solutions to both the public and the private sectors since 2007. Winning any of these bids would have significant positive impact on the Group's performance

The Group has also moved up the product chain to supply valued-added telecommunications solutions in addition to its traditional supply of equipment and services related to infrastructure. The Group has also, through its new subsidiary TeleVAS Sdn Bhd, embarked onto the provision of RFID (Radio Frequency Identification) as solutions for security and increasing efficiency in management in businesses. The Group expects to roll out RFID related projects in 2008.

FSBM sees a new wave of change coming onto the healthcare industry with the realization within the industry of the need to introduce ICT based HealthCare Information Systems to modernize its service delivery and raise its efficiency. FSBM also sees the rising affluence of a growing population and the mushrooming of new hospitals in the country and believes that these would lead to new business opportunities in this growth sector.

On 10 March 2008 FSBM had a soft worldwide launch of its UNOS PRO service for mobile phone users. Since then, we have attracted subscribers from over 75 countries across the world. The Group is focusing on expanding UNOS's presence in China, and Australia. The Group is confident that UNOS PRO will steadily help propel the Group to new heights.

An impact study concluded in mid 2007 by an independent body appointed by the Malaysian Ministry of Education on our Teacher Training program has produced very positive results. We are hopeful that the Ministry will extend the programme to the balance of the teachers. In Indonesia, FSBM completed 2 pilot projects for the headmaster and teachers in 2007. The Group is now in discussion with the Indonesian education authorities on the future deployment of the training programme to more schools in Indonesia.

In the light of the above, the Group is cautiously optimistic that it will register a favorable performance in 2008.
