Selected explanatory notes pursuant to Financial Reporting Standards (FRS) 134 Interim Financial Reporting

1. Basis of preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards (FRS) 134 Interim Financial Reporting, and Paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad (BMSB). The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2007 and the explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements as they provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to the understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2007.

2. Changes in Accounting Policies

During the 2nd quarter ended 30 June 2008, the issued and paid-up share capital was increased from 63,348,250 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each in KKB to 80,188,250 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each by the issuance of 16,000,000 new shares pursuant to acquisition of land and buildings from CMS Steel Bhd as well as issuance of 840,000 new shares pursuant to the exercise of options granted under the Employees' Share Option Scheme at the following option prices:

10. Valuations of property, plant and equipment

On 6 May 2008, KKB Engineering Berhad acquired 1,000,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each, representing 10% of the issued and paid-up share capital of its subsidiary, KKB Industries (Sabah) Sdn Bhd for a total cash consideration of RM1,140,304.40. Subsequent to the acquisition, KKB Industries (Sabah) Sdn Bhd became a 100% owned subsidiary of KKB Engineering Berhad.

15. Review of performance

The Group's current quarter revenue of RM30.6 million declined by 22.3% as compared to RM39.4 million recorded in the preceding year corresponding quarter.

The Steel Fabrication as well as Steel Pipes division within the engineering and manufacturing sector were the main trigger for the lower revenue and hence the squeeze on the Group's current quarter profit before taxation of RM3.6 million from RM4.8 million recorded in the preceding year corresponding quarter.

16. Material changes in the quarterly results compared to the results of the preceding quarter

During the quarter under review, revenue growth improved further to register an increase of 25.4% to reach RM30.6 million (1Q08: RM24.4 million), while profit before taxation of RM3.6 million remained fairly consistent with the preceding quarter. The improved revenue was mainly driven by the Group's Steel Water Pipes and Civil Construction businesses, which contributed combined revenue of RM10.4 million as compared to the preceding 1st quarter's total of RM4.8 million.

17. Prospects

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Board remains cautiously optimistic of achieving a satisfactory set of results for 2008 under the prevailing competitive business environment.
