### NOTES TO THE QUARTERLY FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Selected explanatory notes pursuant to Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134 Interim Financial Reporting

### 1. Basis of Preparation

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134 *Interim Financial Reporting* issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB"), IAS 34 *Interim Financial Reporting* issued by the International Accounting Standards Board and Paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited annual financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 December 2013. The explanatory notes attached to the condensed consolidated interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2013.

### 2. Significant Accounting Policies

The significant accounting policies and methods of computation applied in the interim financial statements are consistent with those adopted in the most recent audited annual financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2013 except for the adoption of the following with effect from 1 January 2014:

# Explanatory notes pursuant to Appendix 9B of Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad

### 15. Detailed Review Of Performance

The Group's current quarter revenue of RM48.5 million (2Q13: RM60.1 million) was 19.3% lower as compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter. This quarter shows a substantial shift in the proportion of revenue contribution on the overall group activities from the Engineering sector of 28% (2Q13: 66%) to the Manufacturing sector of 72% (2Q13: 34%).

### **Engineering Sector**

The Sector registered revenue of RM13.7 million (2Q13: RM39.9 million). The quarter's results ended lower compared to the preceding year 2Q13 in the absence of sizeable jobs/projects undertaken during the quarter.

Construction Division recorded a revenue of RM2.3 million (2Q13: RM14.5 million), representing a reduction of RM12.2 million or 84.1% in the current quarter as a result of lower progress billings from on-going projects and completion of projects by the Civil Construction division.

Revenue from the Steel Fabrication Division reduced by 58.2% over the preceding year corresponding quarter to record RM10.4 million (2Q13: RM24.9 million). Revenue for the quarter were mainly contributed from the existing works involving the fabrication of structural steel works for Petronas LNG Train 9 Project, Structural steel works for SAMUR project, structural steel works for the proposed University College of Technology Sarawak in Sibu and supply of LT/HT Steel Poles.

HDG Division recorded an increase in revenue of 103.3% from RM492K registered in the preceding year corresponding quarter to RM1.0 million this quarter. The improved performance was mainly contributed from the supply of Hot Dip Galvanised Standard Low and High Tension Poles.

### Manufacturing Sector

Revenue from Steel Pipes manufacturing business under subsidiary companies, Harum Bidang Sdn Bhd ("HBSB") and KKB Industries (Sabah) Sdn Bhd, increased by RM15.8 million (101.9%) with an aggregate revenue of RM31.3 million (2Q13: RM15.5 million). The increase in revenue is mainly attributed to the sales of Polyurethane Lined Mild Steel Pipes by HBSB.

LPG Cylinders manufacturing division recorded a decrease in revenue of approximately RM1.2 million, due to lower offtake of LPG cylinders from the Petroleum Companies. The entire 2Q14 revenue of RM3.4 million (2Q13: RM4.6 million) was for the supply of LPG cylinders to its major customer, Petronas Dagangan Berhad.

# 16. Material changes in the quarterly results compared to the results of the preceding quarter

Group's revenue for the quarter of RM48.5 million improved by 13.8% as compared to RM42.6 million registered in the preceding quarter, while profit before taxation of RM8.7 million (1Q14: RM5.4 million) increased by 61.1%. The improved operating results and revenue during the current quarter were mainly driven by the Group's steel pipe manufacturing business.

### 17. Prospects

The Board is cautious that the continued uncertainties in the global economic environment, escalation of costs due to inflationary pressure, volatility of global raw material steel prices and fluctuation of exchange rates are amongst factors that may impact the Group's performance.

The Group continues to explore all opportunities available in our specialized and growing structural steel engineering services with more focus given to the energy related projects. With the completion of the Group's expansion and modernization of its fabrication yard at Lot 777, the Group is actively participating in potential business opportunities in the Major Onshore Fabrication to move up the value chain in Fabrication Engineering and related disciplines, in collaboration with OceanMight Sdn Bhd and other strategic partner(s).

As a result of lower volumes and increasing costs, the Board remained cautious that the Group's outlook for the remaining second half of financial year ending 2014 will prove to be challenging.

The Group's effective tax rate for the current quarter and year to date is lower than the statutory tax rate mainly due to the utilization of reinvestment allowance for the expansion of its Steel Fabrication activities. The decrease is also in line with the decreased of pre-tax profit for the Group corresponding with the decrease in revenue and profit recorded during the quarter and year-to-date.

# 24. Material Litigations

Status update on the Writ of Summons dated 26 June 2012 served by Global Upline Sdn Bhd ("GUSB") to the Company's wholly owned subsidiary, KKB Builders Sdn Bhd ("KKBB"):-

Further to the announcement made on 24 September 2012 pertaining to the arbitration proceedings between KKBB as the Claimant and GUSB as the Respondent, the Arbitrator has given direction as set out in the Procedural Order No. 1, to both parties.

On 12 April 2013, KKBB, through its Advocates, Messrs Battenberg & Talma Advocates, served on the Respondent, Global Upline Sdn Bhd, through its Advocates, Messrs Suhaili & Bong Advocates, and submitted to the Arbitrator and the Kuala Lumpur Regional Centre for Arbitration ("KLRCA") its Statement of Claim, together with the bundle of documents.

On 2 May 2013, KKBB has been served a Defence and Counterclaim by the Respondent, GUSB.

On 22 May 2013, KKBB through its Advocates, Messrs Battenberg & Talma Advocate, filed a Reply and Defence to Counterclaim and submitted the same to the Arbitrator and KLRCA.

The hearing of arbitration has commenced and is on-going.

The legal opinion given by the Company's lawyers is that the Respondent's claim is without basis.

Save as disclosed above, there were no pending material litigations against the Group which might materially and adversely affect the Group's financial position.

No interim dividend has been recommended for payment in the current quarter and financial year-to-date.
