- (ii) proposed bonus issue of up to approximately 139.849 million new Mitrajaya Shares ("Bonus Share(s)"), on the basis of one (1) bonus share for every two (2) existing Mitrajaya Shares held after the Proposed Share Split on the Entitlement Date ("Proposed Bonus Issue");
- (iii) proposed issue of up to approximately 52.444 million new free warrants in Mitrajaya ("Free Warrants" or "Warrants") on the basis of one (1) free warrant for every eight (8) existing Mitrajaya Shares held after the Proposed Share Split and Proposed Bonus Issue on the Entitlement Date ("Proposed Free Warrants Issue"); and
- (iv) proposed amendments to the Memorandum and Articles of Association ("MA") of Mitrajaya to facilitate the implementation of the Proposed Share Split ("Proposed Amendments").

On 25 February 2011, MIDF Investment, on behalf of the Company announced that the basis for the Proposed Bonus Issue and Proposed Free Warrants Issue in terms of number of Bonus Shares and Warrants of 139,848,557 Bonus Shares and 52,443,209 Warrants, respectively as stated in the announcement dated 19 January 2011 as mentioned above has been revised as a result of the expiry of Warrants 2001/2011 on 11 February 2011 and the increase in the issued and paid up share capital of the Company to 135,125,767 shares pursuant to the exercise of 7,136,500 Warrants 2001/2011 prior to its expiry.

Accordingly the maximum number of Bonus Shares and Warrants to be issued pursuant to the Proposed Bonus Issue and Proposed Free Warrants Issue (on the assumption all treasury shares are sold and/or distributed as dividends prior to the relevant Entitlement Date) now comprise up to 135,125,767 Bonus Shares and 50,672,163 Warrants respectively.

On 16 March 2011 and 28 March 2011, the Company obtained approvals from the relevant authorities for the Proposed Share Split and the issuance of Free Warrants to the non-resident shareholders of the company.

On 15 April 2011, the Company obtained approval from Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad for the Proposed Bonus Issue and the Proposed Free Warrants Issue subject to the compliance of the Listing Requirements and shareholders' approval.

B11 Pending Material Litigation

On 4 January 2006, the Company, the Company's wholly owned subsidiary, Dutawani Sdn Bhd ("Dutawani") and its Managing Director, Tan Eng Piow were served with a writ and statement of claim by Pandan Perkasa Sdn Bhd ("PPSB"), for the alleged breach of the Joint venture Agreement and the Suplemental Agreement between the PPSB and Dutawani. The Company's solicitors were of the opinion that PPSB had no case against the Company.

Upon completion of the proceedings of the High Court, the High Court upheld our Counsel's submission of no case to answer and the Court has dismissed PPSB's claim with costs on 23 December 2010. As regards Dutawani's counterclaim against PPSB, the High Court awarded judgment in the sum of RM250,000.00 against PPSB with interest thereon at 8% per annum from 23 December 2010 until the date of full settlement and costs.

The application of PPSB's appeal against the decision of the High Court was sucessful and PPSB has filed in their Record of Appeal in the Court of Appeal.
