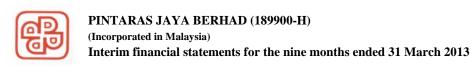

Notes to the Interim Financial Statements

1. Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard (MFRS) No. 134 - Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2012. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 30 June 2012.

This interim financial report is the Group's first MFRS compliant condensed report and hence MFRS 1, *First-time Adoption of Malaysia Financial Reporting Standards* has been applied. The date of transition to the MFRS framework is 1 July 2011. At that transition date, the Group reviewed its accounting policies and considered the transitional opportunities under MFRS 1. The impact of the transition from Financial Reporting Standards (FRS) to MFRS is described in Note 2 below.

2. Significant Accounting Policies and Application of MFRS 1

The audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 30 June 2012 were prepared in accordance with FRS. As the requirements under FRS and MFRS are similar, the significant accounting policies adopted in preparing this condensed report are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2012 except as discussed below:

Quoted equity instruments

Under FRS, the Group designated its investment in quoted equity instruments at fair value through profit or loss in accordance with FRS 139 Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement. Changes in fair value were taken to profit or loss. At the date of transition to MFRS, these quoted equity instruments were redesignated as available-for-sale. Changes in fair value are recognised in other comprehensive income with the exception of impairment losses.

The reconciliations of equity and total comprehensive income for comparative periods and of equity at the date of transition reported under FRS to those reported for those periods and at the date of transition under MFRS are provided in the following pages:

15. Review of Performance of the Company and its Principal Subsidiaries

(a) Current Year 3rd Quarter (3Q2013) versus Preceding Year 3rd Quarter (3Q2012)

The Group recorded a revenue of RM42.4 million in 3Q2013, a decrease of 6% from RM45.1 million in 3Q2012, while profit before taxation rose significantly by 60% to RM17.6 million as compared to the previous corresponding period of RM11.0 million.

Revenue from construction division in 3Q2013 was lower by 5% at RM33.7 million, compared to RM35.4 million in 3Q2012. Despite the slight fall in revenue, profit before taxation surged over 77% to RM12.8 million from RM7.2 million mainly due to higher profits realised from completed projects.

The manufacturing division recorded a revenue and profit before taxation of RM8.8 million and RM1.7 million in 3Q2013, representing a decrease of 9% and 2% respectively compared to the same quarter last year. The decline in current quarter results compared to 3Q2012 was mainly due to lower sales volume as well as lower selling prices.

(b) Current Year-to-date versus Preceding Year Corresponding Period

For the financial period ended 31March 2013, the Group's revenue dropped to RM122.1 million from RM136.1 million in the preceding year. Despite the 10% decrease in revenue, the Group recorded a higher profit before taxation of RM47.1 million as compared to the previous corresponding period of RM42.5 million. The construction division achieved a better profit before taxation despite a lower revenue. This, however, was partly offset by lower contribution from manufacturing division.

Revenue from the construction division slipped by about 10% to RM96.5 million from RM106.8 million as compared to last year. Nevertheless, profit before taxation rose by 34% to RM36.7 million as compared to RM27.4 million in the previous year, primarily due to higher profits realised from completed projects.

The manufacturing division recorded a revenue and profit before taxation of RM25.6 million and RM4.8 million, representing a decrease of 13% and 23% respectively compared to last year. The decline was mainly due to lower sales volume and a downwards revision of selling prices as a result of lower raw material price.

For the 3rd financial quarter under review, the Group recorded a higher revenue and profit before taxation of RM42.4 million and RM17.6 million, representing an increase of 18% and 66% respectively compared to the immediate preceding quarter. The increase was attributable mainly to the improved performance from both the construction and manufacturing divisions.

17. Prospects for the Current Financial Year

The Board expects the construction business to perform well for the remaining fourth quarter based on a strong order book. Tendering activities are further boosted by the progressive roll-out of various infrastructure and property projects both from the public and private sectors. We expect the pace of contract awards to accelerate now that the elections are over. However, the Board expects the shortage of skilled labour, staffing issues and escalation of material prices to pose serious challenges.

On the manufacturing front, our metal container operations remain difficult due to intense competition in the market. We have successfully installed a new coating line and would continue to focus and expand our range of products in order to enhance sales and productivity.

Overall, the Board expects the Group's performance for financial year 2013 to be better than year 2012 and our profitability growth target to remain intact.
