10. Subsequent Events

As at the date of this report, there were no material events subsequent to the current quarter ended 30 September 2020, except as follows:

The private placements Proposals as announced on 17 August 2020 have been approved by members of the Company at an Extraordinary General Meeting held at Holiday Inn Melaka on 7 October 2020.

The proposed private placement I is expected to raise between RM8.17 million under the Minimum Scenario and RM9.63 million under the Maximum Scenario while the proposed private placement II is expected to raise between RM.9.80 million under the Minimum Scenario and RM13.28 million under the Maximum Scenario. Together the two proposed private placements are expected to raise between RM17.97 million under the Minimum Scenario and RM22.91 million under the Maximum Scenario.

The proceeds of the proposed private placements have been earmarked towards development expenditure of the Group's existing housing development projects with an amount of RM6.0 million while the rest will be for working capital and expenses in respect of the two private placements.

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, private placement I is expected to be completed during the fourth quarter of 2020 whereas private placement II is expected to be completed within the quarter ending 31 March 2021.

11. Changes to the composition of the Group

There were no changes in the composition of the Group in the current quarter under review, except as follows:

(a) On 30 September 2020, Sinmah Axis Healthcare Sdn. Bhd. (formerly known as Sinmah Amegajaya Healthcare Sdn. Bhd.) ("Sinmah Axis Healthcare"), the 99% owned subsidiary of SCB had entered into a Share Sale Agreement ("SSA 1") with Azliana Binti Allias ("the Purchaser") to dispose of 850 ordinary shares, representing 85% of the equity interest in SAH Mutiara Sdn. Bhd. ("SAH Mutiara") ("the Sale Shares 1") for a total cash consideration of RM1.00 only ("the Disposal 1").

- (b) On 30 September 2020, Sinmah Axis Healthcare also entered into a Share Sale Agreement ("SSA 2") with Azliana Binti Allias ("the Purchaser") to dispose of 700 ordinary shares, representing 70% of the equity interest in SAH Medical Center (Batu Kawan) Sdn. Bhd. ("SMC Batu Kawan") ("the Sale Shares 2") for a total cash consideration of RM1.00 only ("the Disposal 2").
- (c) On 30 September 2020, Sinmah Development Sdn. Bhd. ("Sinmah Development"), the wholly-owned subsidiary of SCB had entered into a Share Sale Agreement ("SSA 3") with Azliana Binti Allias ("the Purchaser") to dispose of 70,000 ordinary shares, representing 70% of the equity interest in Sinmah Rising Development Sdn. Bhd. (formerly known as Sinmah Encorp Development Sdn. Bhd.) ("Sinmah Rising Development") ("the Sale Shares 3") for a total cash consideration of RM1.00 only ("the Disposal 3").

The considerations for the above disposals have been received and the disposals have been deemed completed. As such, Sinmah Axis Healthcare, SMC Batu Kawan and Sinmah Rising Development have ceased to be members of the Sinmah Group.

12. Contingent Liabilities

The Company provides corporate guarantee to financial institutions for all unsecured credit facilities granted to subsidiaries amounting to RM82.11 million as at 30 September 2020.

13. Capital Commitments

There were no material capital commitments not provided for in the interim financial statements as at 30 September 2020.

For the current quarter ended 30 September 2020, the food segment recorded a lower revenue of RM20.03 million as compared with RM68.37 million in the corresponding quarter ended 30 September 2019, a decrease of 71%. The decrease was mainly due to decrease in sales volume and average selling prices of live broilers sold during the quarter ended 30 September 2020 as compared to the corresponding quarter ended 30 September 2019.

The property development segment posted a higher revenue of RM3.40 million in the current quarter ended 30 September 2020 as compared to the revenue of RM1.31 million in the corresponding quarter ended 30 September 2019, an increase of more than 100%. This was due to higher recognition of revenue on the percentage of completion basis during the current quarter ended 30 September 2020 as compared to the corresponding quarter ended 30 September 2019.

The healthcare division commenced operations during the quarter ended 31 December 2019. Hence, there was no revenue recorded during the corresponding quarter ended 30 September 2019.

As total revenue decreased, the Group posted a loss attributable to owners of the parent of RM5.22 million during the current quarter ended 30 September 2020 as opposed to a profit attributable to owners of the parent of RM8.89 million in the corresponding quarter ended 30 September 2019. Furthermore, during the corresponding quarter ended 30 September 2019, there was a gain on disposal of feed-mill assets of RM17.87 million but there is no such gain during the current quarter ended 30 September 2020.

For the nine months period ended 30 September 2020, the food segment recorded a lower revenue of RM89.44 million as compared with RM134.57 million in the corresponding period ended 30 September 2019, a decrease of 34%. The decrease was mainly due to decrease in sales volume of live broilers resulting from decrease in trading of live broilers activity during the nine months ended 30 September 2020 as compared to the corresponding period ended 30 September 2019.

The property development segment posted a lower revenue of RM8.36 million in the nine months ended 30 September 2020 as compared to the revenue of RM11.75 million in the corresponding period ended 30 September 2019, a decrease of 29%. This was due to lower recognition of revenue on the percentage of completion basis during the nine months period ended 30 September 2020 as compared to the corresponding period ended 30 September 2019. This was mainly due to lower sales of properties during the nine months ended 30 September 2020 caused by temporary closure of operations due to the COVID-19 pandemic outbreak.

The healthcare division commenced operations during the quarter ended 31 December 2019. Hence, there was no revenue recorded during the corresponding period ended 30 September 2019.

As total revenue decreased, the Group posted a loss attributable to owners of the parent of RM15.20 million during the nine months period ended 30 September 2020 as opposed to a profit attributable to owners of the parent of RM8.89 million in the corresponding period ended 30 September 2019. This was mainly due to impairment loss on trade receivables amounted to RM7.0 million during the nine months ended 30 September 2020 compared to RM2.0 million during the corresponding period ended 30 September 2019 coupled with there being a profit on disposal of feed-mill assets of RM17.87 million during the corresponding period ended 30 September 2019 but no such gain during the current period ending 30 September 2020.

15. Comparison to Preceding Quarter's Results

The Group's performance for the current quarter ended 30 September 2020 compared to the previous quarter ended 30 June 2020 is as shown in Table 4 and Table 5 below:

For the current quarter ended 30 September 2020, the food segment posted a lower revenue of RM20.03 million compared to the turnover of RM34.04 million recorded in the previous quarter ended 30 June 2020, a decrease of 41%. The decrease was mainly due to decrease in sales volume of live broilers during the current quarter ended 30 September 2020.

The property development segment posted a higher revenue of RM3.40 million in the current quarter ended 30 September 2020 as compared to the revenue of RM2.05 million in the preceding quarter ended 30 June 2020, an increase of 66%. This was due to higher recognition of revenue on the percentage of completion basis in the current quarter ended 30 September 2020 as compared to previous quarter ended 30 June 2020.

The healthcare segment recorded a higher revenue of RM28,000 during the quarter ended 30 September 2020 as compared to RM3,000 during the preceding quarter ended 30 June 2020, an increase of more than 100%. This was due to the upliftment lockdown measures in combating the COVID-19 pandemic outbreak by the Government of Malaysia which resulted in an increase in number of patients seeking treatment during the quarter under review.

Although revenue decreased, the Group posted a lower loss attributable to owners of the parent of RM5.22 million during the current quarter ended 30 September 2020 compared to a loss attributable to owners of the parent of RM7.62 million during the preceding quarter ended 30 June 2020. The lower loss during the current quarter ended 30 September 2020 was mainly due to an impairment loss on trade receivables of RM4.00 million was incurred during the previous quarter ended 30 June 2020 compared to no impairment loss incurred during the current quarter ended 30 September 2020.

16. Prospects

As at the date of this report, the average selling prices of live broilers is lower than the average selling prices during the quarter ended 30 September 2020.

The country is experiencing the third wave of COVID-19 pandemic outbreak whereby all states, barring Pahang, Perlis and Kelantan, have been placed under Conditional Movement Control Order ("CMCO") with effect from 9 November 2020 to 6 December 2020. This could have an adverse impact on the Group for the coming quarter ending 31 December 2020. Hence, the Group is reliant upon the two proposed private placements as explained in Note 10 above to provide additional cash flows to the Group.

As such, the Group is expecting a challenging fourth quarter of the financial year ending 31 December 2020.

25. Material Litigations

There was no material litigation for the current quarter under review, except for the Group's appeal against the additional tax liability and penalty on two (2) of the Company's subsidiary companies which has now been forwarded by the Inland Revenue Department to the Special Commissioners of Income Tax for registration for trial. The above matters were fixed for case management before the Special Commissioners of Income Tax ("SCIT") in Johor Bahru on 1 November 2018. The counsel for the Company's subsidiary companies requested for a date to file statement of agreed facts and statement of issues to be tried. The SCIT had directed the parties to attend case management on 22 February 2019 in Putrajaya and to file the statement of agreed facts and issues to be tried.

On 22 February 2019, the parties requested more time to finalise the statement of agreed facts and statement of issues to be tried. The counsel for the Appellant (i.e. the Company's subsidiary companies) requested for hearing dates to be fixed and for the statements to be filed before the hearing. However, the learned Special Commissioner informed the Appelant's counsel that she would like to ensure that all cause papers are filed before a hearing date is fixed. In this regard, the SCIT has directed the following:

- (1) The Appellant to file statements of agreed facts, issues to be tried and index on/by 24 May 2019; and
- (2) Parties to attend case management fixed on 24.5.2019 to update SCIT on whether the cause papers above have been filed.

On 24 May 2019, the SCIT set the dates for trial to be held on 27 and 28 April 2021.
