1. Review of Performance

The current quarter results showed a Group revenue of RM52.8 million and a profit before taxation of RM6.9 million as compared to a revenue of RM46.8 million and loss before taxation of RM1.2 million in the corresponding quarter of the previous financial year.

The increase in revenue was mainly due to the increase in sales volume of 46%. The increase in profit before taxation of RM8.1 million was mainly due to higher margin recorded during the current quarter arising from higher production volume, lower finance costs and corporate expenses compared to those of the corresponding quarter of the previous financial year and receipt of the judgment sum cum interest of RM1.889 million, being a legal case awarded in favour of a subsidiary.

Variation of Results against Preceding Quarter

The group revenue of RM52.8 million for the current quarter was higher than that of the immediate preceding quarter of RM42.7 million mainly due to increase in sales volume of 25%.

The Group recorded a profit before taxation of RM6.9 million for the current quarter compared to a profit of RM4.6 million in the immediate preceding quarter and this was mainly due to the receipt of the judgment sum and interest of RM1.889 million, now awarded to subsidiary.

2. Current Year Prospects

In view of the global financial crisis, the Group has taken proactive action towards cost optimization and consolidates its position to mitigate the adverse effects. Barring unforeseen circumstances, the Group is maintaining a positive outlook on the performance for the coming financial year ending 31st December 2009.

10. Changes in Material Litigation

There were no changes in material litigation since the last Balance Sheet date up to the date of issuance of this quarterly report except for the legal suit between our wholly owned subsidiary, Tai Kwong Yokohama Battery Industries Sdn Bhd ("The Company") and Banly Holding Sdn Bhd ("Banly Holding").

The result of the Court of Appeal filed on 10th Aug 2009 are as follows:

- a) the Court has given the Company judgment on its claim for the return of the sum of RM338,500 which should carry interest at 8% from the date of the original judgment;
- b) the Court has rejected the Counterclaim, which means that the Company is entitled to get back the entire sum deposited with Banly Holding solicitors with all rolled up interest. The company has received the sum RM1.889 million from Banly Holding on 4th September 2009;
- c) the Company has been awarded costs in both the High Court and the Court of Appeal, to be taxed if not agreed.
