A1. Basis of Preparation

This interim financial statement is unaudited and is prepared in accordance with FRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and Paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Malaysia") and should be read in conjunction with the Group's annual audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2012.

The accounting policies and presentation adopted by the Group in this financial statement are consistent with those adopted in the latest audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 December 2012, except for the following revised and amendments to Financial Reporting Standards ("FRSs") that are effective for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2013:

Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS")

The Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") has on 7 August 2013, announced that the transitional period to adopt the MFRS framework for transitional entities has been extended for an additional one year. Therefore, the Group being the transitional entities will adopt the MFRS framework in their financial statements for the year ending 31 December 2015. The MFRS framework was introduced by MASB to converge the Malaysia's existing FRS framework with the International Financial Reporting Standards ("IFRS") framework.

The Group is currently assessing the impact of the financial effects of the differences between FRSs and accounting standards under the MFRS framework. Should there be differences arose from the adoption of MFRS framework, the Group will be required to restate the comparative financial statements to amounts reflecting the application of MFRS in their financial period beginning on 1 January 2015. The adjustments will be made against the opening retained profits retrospectively and an explicit and unreserved statement of compliance with IFRSs will be made in the financial statements.

A2. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The Group's operations are not significantly affected by any seasonal or cyclical factors.

The single tier final dividend of 1%, amounting to RM1,878,040 in respect of the financial year ended 31 December 2012 which was approved by shareholders at the 10th Annual General Meeting held on 27 May 2013 had been paid on 27 June 2013 to shareholders whose names appeared in the Record of Depositors at the close of business on 12 June 2013.

B EXPLANATORY NOTES IN COMPLIANCE WITH LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF THE BURSA SECURITIES

B1. Review of the Performance

(a) Performance of the current quarter against the preceding year corresponding quarter

For the current quarter under review, the Group recorded revenue and profit before tax of RM45.446 million and RM15.201 million respectively, representing a 64.2% increase in revenue and 104.0% increase in profit before tax over the previous year's corresponding quarter of RM27.672 million and RM7.450 million respectively.

The performance of the Group's 2 main operating segments was as follows:

Property Development

The property development segment registered a 69.0% increase in revenue to RM43.121 million, compared to RM25.512 million previously, while the segment's profit before tax increased by 108.7% to RM14.853 million from RM7.117 million previously. The improved revenue and profit before tax was mainly due to faster construction progress ahead of schedule for certain residential projects, as well as positive buyer response for our Industrial Park.

Property Management

The property management segment registered rental revenue of RM2.022 million during the quarter under review, a 15.4% increase from previous year's RM1.752 million, while this segment's profit before tax increased by 112.6% to RM0.927 million, as compared to RM0.436 million recorded previously. The improved rental revenue and profit before tax was mainly because of contributions from the higher occupancy rate of the new terms of tenancy, which took effect from June 2013 onwards.

(b) Performance of the current period against the preceding corresponding period

For the current financial period to date, the Group recorded a revenue of RM114.974 million and profit before tax of RM32.502 million, versus revenue of RM78.260 million and profit before tax of RM21.804 million of the preceding corresponding financial period.

Property Development

The faster construction progress ahead of schedule for certain residential projects and good sales response for our Industrial Park have enabled the property development segment to register 52.2% higher revenue of RM108.566 million, compared to RM71.338 million of the preceding corresponding financial period.

The higher revenue also helped to push the segment's profit before tax to RM30.954 million, 62.0% better than RM19.106 achieved in the preceding corresponding financial period.

Property Management

Rental revenue from the property management segment for the financial period to date decreased 1.1%, from RM5.702 million to RM5.642 million and profit before tax decreased 33.7%, from RM3.337 million to RM2.212 million. The lower profitability was because the higher occupancy rate of the new terms of tenancy only commenced in June 2013 onwards. Also, there is no gain on disposal of an investment property this period as compared to the amount of RM0.730 million as in the preceding corresponding financial period.

B2. Comparison with Immediate Preceding Quarter's Results

Compared to the preceding quarter's results ended 30 June 2013, the Group recorded 17.7% higher revenue, from RM38.621 million to RM45.446 million, as a result of faster construction progress ahead of schedule for certain residential projects as well as continued good response for our Industrial Park.

Correspondingly, the Group recorded 54.2% higher profit before tax to RM15.201 million for the current quarter under review, compared to the preceding quarter's R9.857 million.

B3. Prospects

The Group will continue to align its property development offerings to market demand, and be prudent in its business strategies in property management services.

The Group expects to achieve satisfactory performance for the financial year ending 31 December 2013.
